## English Language Certificate Program (ELCP) – English Only

- Student needs English Proficiency
- Intensive Academic English – 25 hours of class plus one hour each week of Conversation Tutor plus ELP Buddy Program, etc.
- Minimum A1 (CEFR) – should have a basic level of English (can read, write, speak a simple sentence in English)
- Minimum 17 years of age
- Serious student
- Minimum weeks: 7 weeks – one level of ELCP plus one week in advance for Orientation (2 months total)
- 6 entry dates per year (every two months program begins)
- Online pre-test available when application is in.
- Placement test during first week of Orientation

## **Pathway: English Language Certificate Program (ELCP) with **Conditional Admission** into Undergraduate Studies or Associate Diploma Programs**

- Student needs English Proficiency
- Minimum A1 (CEFR) – should have a basic level of English (can read, write, speak a simple sentence in English)
- Minimum 17 years of age
- Serious student with strong academic high school transcripts to meet UGuelph admission requirements
- Minimum weeks: 14 weeks – two levels of ELCP for Levels 9 & 10
- 6 entry dates per year (every two months program begins)

- Online pre-test available when application is in.
- Placement test during first week of Orientation
- Continue to Undergraduate Studies in another program that is not offered through IAP or GAP
- Must complete a minimum of 14 weeks of the program to meet English Proficiency for the University (required completion of both levels 9 & 10)
- Student will receive two letters of offer: one from ELP and the other from UGuelph Admissions Office

Program costs: increments of 7 or 14 weeks (14 weeks cost break).  
For pathway minimum is 2 levels-9 & 10
