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Integrated Admission Pathway (IAP):

- Students begin their U of Guelph degree while they study English as the same time.
- Pathway is 12 months from September 2020 to August 2021
 - Meet academic requirements for university and program applying for
 - Minimum 5.5 IELTS or 56 TOEFL iBT

- Bachelor of Arts (All majors and with coop options)
- Bachelor of Commerce (Undeclared)
- Bachelor of Science (Mathematical Science and Environment Geomatics with coop options)
- Student could identify another major within these 3 degrees to see if they qualify for that program, but no guarantees.
- Student will take English language Pathway Courses and degree credit courses (5 x .5 credit courses – one semester of courses).
- The first semester degree credit course is a ‘sheltered’ course. This means that it is only for IAP students. This same course is available to other U of Guelph students, but not in the time allocated for IAP only students. Since it will be the first time for IAP students taking a degree credit courses, we want to slowly introduce and integrate IAP students into university studies. Plus students are not at the university proficiency level therefore, professor and IAP instructors work together on supporting IAP students through their first course (continually monitoring their progression in the course).
- In the Winter semester, IAP students will take 2 degree-credit courses in a regular scheduled university course along with other university students.
- In the Summer semester, IAP students will take 2 ONLINE degree credit courses with other university students. Online learning is now a normal and optional practice for students. Many international and domestic students take online courses throughout their university studies to minimize their study time or to gain a minor or another major (many co-op students take online courses during the work semesters).

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Support to IAP students:

- **Experienced English language instructors** and faculty members will guide their learning.
- **Conversation Tutors:** Once per week, IAP students schedule one-hour sessions with their Conversation Tutor (who is a highly qualified U of Guelph student)
- **English Language Program Buddies:** University of Guelph students buddy up with IAP students. They meet on a social and cultural basis. Total university student experience. Meet at least once a week. ELP Buddy becomes a friend, a companion, a mentor and learner, and helps to improve the IAP student's English language skills.
- **Supported Learning Groups** are available with each degree credit course IAP students take. SLGs are to give support for students' academic success. Additional studies outside of class time.
- **English Learning House:** Students live on campus in a supported living and learning environment where they will build their network of Canadian friends and develop real English skills.

The IAP student will experience:

- **IAP students use all the resources of UG** including classrooms, library, eating facilities, athletics, health services, etc. Classrooms are across the campus in many different buildings just like a regular university of Guelph student. Total integration on campus.
- **Canadian Culture Program and Activities:** each week IAP student have fun activities on and off campus
