
University Transfer

The province of British Columbia has established the BC Transfer Guide, which allows students to transition from one post-secondary institution to another. You can study one to two years at Camosun and transfer your credits to a university to finish your bachelor's degree. It is also possible to transfer to universities in other provinces across Canada.

University Transfer (UT) allows you to start your bachelor's degree at Camosun and transition seamlessly to internationally renowned universities and programs.

You will receive one-on-one academic advising support to choose your courses, develop your personal learning plan, and transition to the university of your choice.


WIL EXPERIENCES:

CO-OP — Alternate between full-time studies and full-time paid work with one or more employers. You will need to complete at least two work terms (minimum 420 hours each) to graduate with a "Co-op Education" designation.

INTERNSHIP — A full-time or part-time work term, which may be paid or unpaid. You will need to complete at least one work term (minimum 300 hours) to graduate with an "Internship" designation.

PRACTICUM — Observe working professionals on the job and practice the skills you have learned in class. You will need to complete a specific number of supervised practice hours per week (unpaid) to fulfill the practicum requirements for your program.

STRATEGIC VOLUNTEERING — Engage with the local community in a meaningful way, contributing your time and energies to a worthy cause, while enhancing your knowledge and skills, and expanding your network.



ESL- a- Academic Ungrading Bes

If you do not meet the English, Biology, Chemistry, Math or Physics requirement for direct entry to the program of your choice, you can meet this requirement through our on-campus ESL & Academic Upgrading program. Depending on your level, you will be placed in the appropriate ESL or academic upgrading course, to work towards attaining the direct entry requirement. In specific cases, you may take up to three academic courses along with your ESL or Academic Upgrading courses. If you are unsure about your level, please contact us regarding on-shore and off-shore Camosun assessments.

The Camosun Intensive Summer Language Institute (CISLI) is designed for motivated students who wish to complete two levels of Academic English upgrading in ONE semester!

If you have an Academic IELTS overall score of 5.5, with no sub-score less than 5.0, a TOEFL ibt score of 71, with no sub-score less than 16, OR you have successfully completed the ELD 062/064 levels and have a recommendation from your instructor, you can join the ONE semester CISLI program in May 2020.

Upon successful completion of CISLI, you will embark on your academic journey in September 2020.


CELA students have the opportunity to practice English while exploring the many tourist attractions that Victoria has to offer.











International students at Camosun have the option of living in a homestay or on their own. Our Housing Coordinator can help you explore each option and ensure your accommodation in Victoria is safe and comfortable.

- **Homestay with food** You are provided with a private bedroom (including furniture and basic household necessities) in the home of a local host family. You share common spaces in the family home (bathrooms, living rooms, kitchen). The host family buys the food and cooks dinner and you prepare your own breakfast and lunch.
- Homestay without food You are provided with a private bedroom (including furniture and basic household necessities) in the home of a local host family. You share common spaces in the family home (bathrooms, living rooms, kitchen). You buy and cook your own food using the shared kitchen.
- **Living on your own** You find and rent an apartment or house, with other students or on your own. You are responsible for all living expenses and start-up costs (furniture, cookware, bedding).

- High school graduation or be 19 years old on the first day of classes.
- English proficiency (one of): **
 - » BC high school English 12 or equivalent with final grade of C+ or better
 - » IELTS (Academic) score of 6.0 overall (no sub-score less than 6.0)
 - » TOEFL iBT score of 78 overall (no sub-score less than 19)
 - » PTE Academic score of 54 overall (no sub-score less than 50)
 - » Cambridge Assessment of English: C1 Advanced score of 174 overall (no sub-score less than 169)
 - » CAEL CE score of 60 overall (no sub-score less than 60)
 - » GTEC CBT score of 1200 overall (minimum sub-scores: Reading 325; Writing 270; Speaking 260; Listening 335)
 - » Recognized ESL pathway partner certificate

HOW TO APPLY

1. APPLY ONLINE

Submit online application through camosun.ca/intl-apply (pay \$100 non-refundable application fee). Make sure to submit supporting documents as well.

Supporting documents may include:

- » Transcripts (high school/post-secondary). Scan of official documents is acceptable to submit with application. Official, sealed transcripts must be received by Camosun International. Please provide certified English translations for all transcripts.
- » Proof of English proficiency
- » Scan of passport (pages showing photo, personal information, and signature)
- » Scan of study permit (if applicable)
- » Program-specific documents (if applicable)

2. RECEIVE LETTER OF ELIGIBILITY

Once your application has been reviewed, and if we determine we can offer you a seat in the program, you will receive a Letter of Eligibility and details regarding your Tuition and Fee Deposit. You must pay the tuition and fee deposit in order to receive the Letter of Acceptance, which is required to apply for a study permit (and entry visa if necessary). The Tuition and Fee Deposit is non-refundable and non-transferable.*

3. RECEIVE LETTER OF ACCEPTANCE

Submit your application for your study permit (and entry visa if necessary) to your local visa office, and make your travel arrangements to come to Canada in time for the New Student Orientation.

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
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
