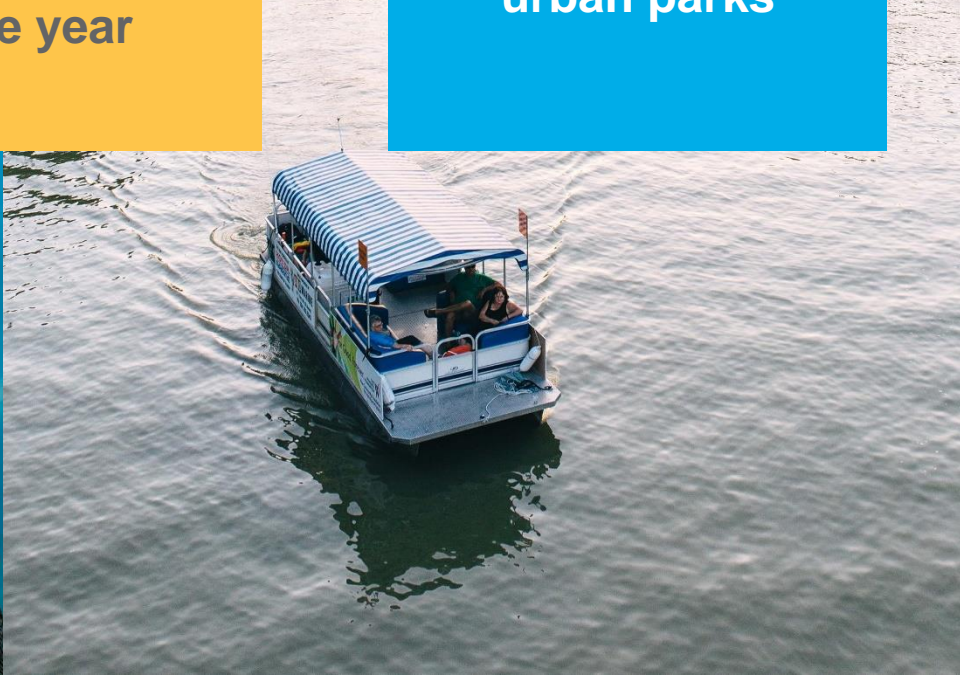

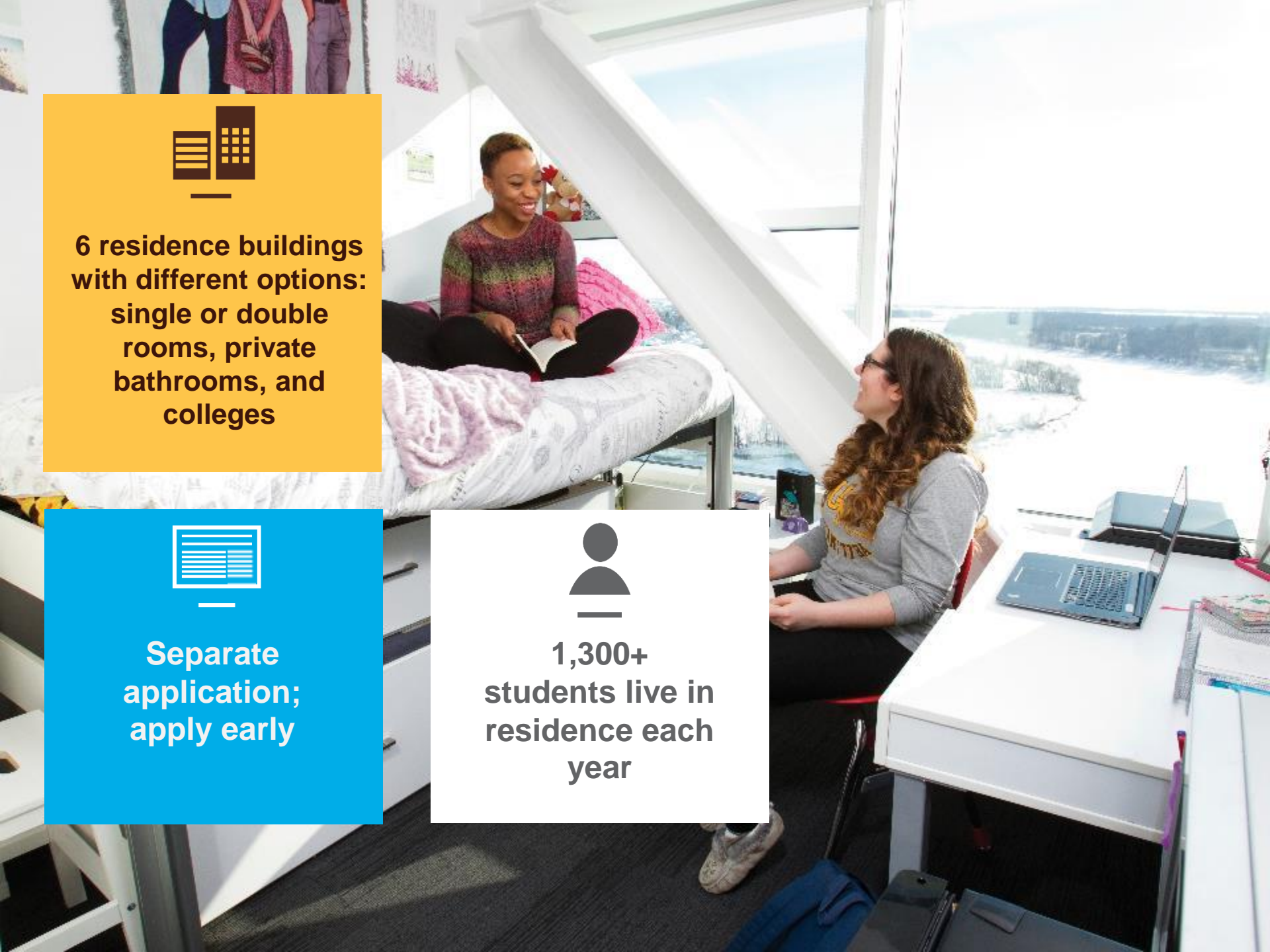

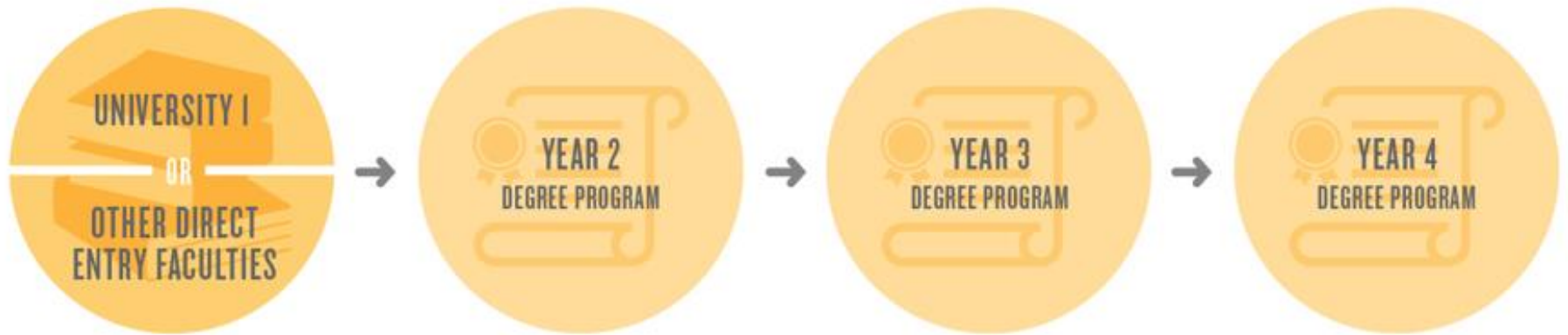

Application Information

University 1 Requirements

University 1

1. A minimum 70% average over four Grade 12 credits
2. One credit of Grade 12 English with a minimum grade of 60%

Direct entry

Varies by program – umanitoba.ca/applynow

English Language Proficiency Requirements

- TOEFL iBT: 86 overall band score with a minimum of 20 in each component required for admission
- IELTS: 6.5 overall band score required for admission
- Students completing the Canadian curriculum: a grade of 75% or higher in your senior level English Literature course (students completing the Manitoba curriculum must present two 40S English courses)



English Language Centre (ELC)

- Average class size is less than 12 students
- Research shows that students who completed the Intensive Academic English program (IAEP):
 - Had higher marks in their degree program than other international students
 - Had higher first year GPAs than Canadian students



English Language Centre (ELC)

Intensive Academic English Program (IAEP)

- The U of M will accept students on the successful completion of Level 5 of the IAEP
- Conditional admission is available to
 - University 1 for direct entry students
 - Science, Arts and General Studies for advanced entry students
- IELTS 4.5 guarantees placement in the IAEP program, but students do not need an English proficiency test to apply (they will take placement test upon arrival)
- Level 5 entrance requirement: IELTS 5.5

English Language Centre

Choose ELC if...

- You would like to study academic English full-time before your undergraduate studies
- You would like conditional admission to an undergraduate degree program
- You would like small class sizes and workshops to focus on building academic English skills

Financial Support

- Additional awards listed on our Awards Database
- Student aid and bursary opportunities
- Applicants who apply by March 1st are automatically considered for entrance scholarships (based on interim grades)
- Entrance scholarships range from \$1,000-\$3,000
