- **Duolingo (DUO): temporarily accepted as an English exam for admission purposes only for January 2021 and May 2021. Programs that do not display "DUO" do not accept Duolingo. For the two semesters noted, all IELTS band requirements for selected programs are removed on a temporary basis since Duolingo does not have bands for reading, writing, speaking, and listening. Please refer to appendix A.**
- IELTS: We only accept the "Academic" version of the exam for admission purposes.
- TOEFL: **We will temporarily be accepting the TOEFL Special Home Edition.** We do not accept TOEFL ITP / PDT.
- Students must submit **transcripts** and **diploma** both in the original language and certified English translation.
- Once admitted to the program, students may be required to take the Langara English Test (LET) and/or Math Diagnostics Test (MDT) or their equivalents, necessary to fulfill pre-requisites and complete their program.
- **Co-op Placement** is a paid position for a specific academic term spread through the student's educational program. To qualify for the Co-op Program, student must fulfill some program requirements and complete additional credits. Students must end their program on an academic term. **Practicum** is an unpaid volunteer work conducted for a short period. Visit www.langara.ca/co-operative-education for more information.
